A Body Plethysmograph, sometimes called a body box, can help diagnosis lung and airway diseases such as Asthma, COPD, Pulmonary Fibrosis, etc.

Symptoms that might suggest a lung function test include:

- Chest tightness, pain or pressure
- Coughing, especially with mucus
- Difficulty taking a deep breath
- Shortness of breath
- Wheezing



Body Plethysmography is an accurate and relatively quick test. Please note that we still offer Nitrogen Washout for patients who can't do the body box.
